Interac e-Transfer

Interac e-Transfer is a simple, convenient, and secure way to send and receive money directly from one bank account to another. All you need is access to online or mobile banking through a participating financial institution, and you can send money to TMCCC — without sharing any personal financial information. It's a great alternative to cheques and cash.

To make offering by Interac e-Transfer, please do the following:

- 1. Go to your Online Banking site and click on the link for an Interac e-Transfer.
- 2. Set up TMCCC as a Recipient (Contact) for the e-Transfer function. Where you are asked to provide the Recipient's email address, enter offering@tmccc.ca.
- 3. Make the e-Transfer, fill in the required information, including the amount of your offering.
- 4. In the message field of your transaction request, please indicate:
 - Donor's name (if it is different than your own name),
 - Offering number, and

 What fund(s) you are wanting your offering to go to. You can split your offering between funds if you so desire. (Example: If your offering is \$100, your note could say - \$50 GF, \$25 BF, and \$25 MF) or any other combination of amounts and funds you would like to offer.

Biblical Interpretation Series – How to Study Your Bible

(By Jonathan Lai - Spring 2020)

The online workshop series has the following objectives:-

- 1) You will develop a stance for why authorial intent should control interpretation.
- 2) You will be able to articulate an effective interpretive strategy for approaching any passage in Scripture including "problem passages".
- 3) You will use various interpretive principles to develop a rich understanding of different aspects of a single passage of your choice through the term, thereby building a rich detailed understanding of that passage throughout the term. This is the main project you will work towards in the term.

And the following responsibilities:

- You will be responsible to commit 1-2 hours outside of our workshop time to work on your passage each week and present your work each time. (Jonathan will provide resources to support your work.)
- 2. You will give a short presentation (~5 min) to the group on each of the following topics based on your passage through the semester (historical context, literary context, grammatical context, word study, final exegesis and application).
- 3. You will need a laptop with Zoom teleconferencing capability (video camera and mic), and of course, your Bible and a place to take notes.

Schedule: Weekly 1.5 hour sessions

Workshop Topic:-

- Introduction and Foundations;
- Historical Context;
- Literary Context;
- Grammar and Language;
- Word Study;
- Interpretation and Application;
- Work on Final Presentation (Breakout Groups);
- Difficult Passages, Conclusions.
